Opportunities currently exist to join the Choir of Christ Church North Adelaide

As well as an almost endless number of voluntary positions, there are also a limited number of Choral Scholarships available to dedicated secondary and tertiary students (of any discipline).

Christ Church is a traditional Anglican Church where music is highly valued.

The mixed voice Choir sings at weekly Choral Eucharist and Choral Evensong services, drawing on a very wide-ranging repertoire spanning the rich tradition of church choral music. The choir is planning a tour (with Pilgrim Church choir) to the UK in 2017/18.

The benefits of singing in a church choir are many, and include:

- performance experience
- improved sight-reading and musicianship
- development of ensemble and teamwork skills
- > exploring a wide range of repertoire: new pieces each week
- friendship with like-minded people in a close community environment

Sunday 10am Choral Eucharist (rehearsal at 9am)

Sunday 6pm Choral Evensong (rehearsal at 5pm)

Singers need not be Anglican, nor have any particular religious affiliation. Applicants should have had some experience as choral musicians, and will undergo an (informal) audition. The ability to read music is essential, as there is a high turn-over of music.
